VISIT OF THE RELICS OF ST BERNADETTE

It was announced recently by the Archbishop that the relics of St Bernadette of Lourdes will come to the Cathedral on Sunday 11th September, staying overnight, before departing for St Joseph's Cathedral, Swansea, on Monday 12th.

St Bernadette was a young girl when she saw the Lady in the grotto in Lourdes. The Lady eventually revealed herself to be the 'Immaculate Conception' a term that was unknown to Bernadette, but one which confirmed to her Parish Priest that she was telling the truth. Since then, Lourdes has become a major centre of pilgrimage and Marian devotion.

We seek her intercession that we may all be authentic witnesses to the Gospel in our own times.

MASS INTENTIONS

The origin of Masses being offered for particular intentions, especially for the dead, has a long history in the Church, even to her very beginnings. On the tomb of Abercius, the second century Bishop of Phrygia, the inscription asks for prayers for the repose of his soul. St Monica asked her son, St Augustine, to remember her 'at the altar of the Lord, wherever you may be.'

We have Masses offered for particular intentions, for the living and the dead, in good times and bad.
