## MASS INTENTIONS

---

The origin of Masses being offered for particular intentions, especially for the dead, has a long history in the Church, even to her very beginnings. On the tomb of Abercius, the second century Bishop of Phrygia, the inscription asks for prayers for the repose of his soul. St Monica asked her son, St Augustine, to remember her 'at the altar of the Lord, wherever you may be.'

We have Masses offered for particular intentions, for the living and the dead, in good times and bad. Envelopes are available at the entrance to the Cathedral.

If the desired date is already taken, the Mass will be offered on the nearest 'free' day. I ask that if you have a particular date in mind, the intention is handed in a few weeks in advance.

## ALERT LEVEL: ZERO

We are back to alert level zero, meaning that the compulsory two metre distance has been lifted. I only ask that you continue to be considerate of others who worship at the Cathedral.

**Masks remain mandatory**, unless you are medically exempt, and until we receive further guidance from the Bishops' Conference.
