### Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

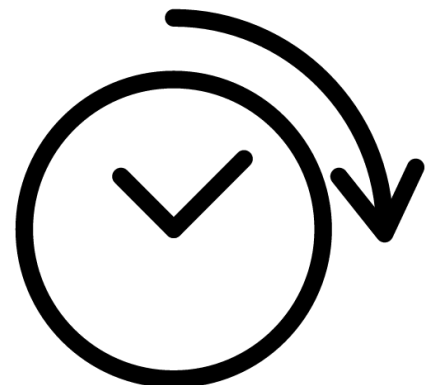
