FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

3rd April 2022 | Sunday Cycle: Year C | Psalter: Week 1 | Missal Page: 144

Traditionally, the Fifth Sunday of Lent marked the beginning of Passiontide. To mark the beginning of Passiontide all images were covered, this tradition has been maintained, and so as you entered the Cathedral today you will have noticed that all images, with the exception of the Stations of the Cross have been veiled. Crosses will remain veiled until after the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday; all other images will remain veiled until the Easter Vigil.

One of the reasons for this is related to the Gospel on Thursday of the Fifth Week of Lent, "Jesus hid himself and left the temple."

From the Fifth Sunday of Lent, our attention is fixed on the events that will unfold in Jerusalem around the Passion and Death of the Lord. We cover the images so that there can be no 'distraction'; our gaze should be fixed.

To help us prepare for Holy Week, on Saturday 9th April the **Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be available at the Cathedral from 10:30am—5:15pm.
