## Prayer and Worship

**Instructions for Attending the Celebration of Mass** - I would like to extend a personal welcome back to the Cathedral to all those who are attending Mass for the first time. As you can see, things are in no way back to normal, yet. The **stewards** are available at the back of the Cathedral to help and guide you. I am very grateful to the stewards for their dedication and commitment. Without them, the Cathedral could not open. The **Track and Trace** system which is in place is there to safeguard visitors to the Cathedral for the celebration of Mass.

**First Friday Devotions** - Devotions to the Sacred Heart take place this Friday evening, beginning with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 5:00pm.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** - The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available in **the Mostyn Room** at scheduled times throughout the week. Access into the Mostyn Room is via the courtyard. Times of Confessions this week will be:

### ***Tuesday and Thursday:***

from 12:00pm until 12:30pm.

### ***Saturday:***

from 11:00am until 12:00pm.

If you would like to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation outside of these times, please phone Clergy House to book an appointment.

**Lectio Divina** - The virtual *Lectio Divina* Prayer Group continues via Zoom **each Thursday afternoon**, beginning at **12:45pm**, for the time being.

**Evening Prayer (Vespers)** - It's such a blessing to gather together, albeit virtually, and pray the prayer of the

Church. Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction takes place each Sunday, beginning at 4:30pm.

With the exception of Thursday, Evening Prayer will begin at 5:40pm (5:30pm on Thursdays).

**Praying For Vocations** - Praying for vocations to the priesthood and religious life in our Archdiocese is one of our fundamental duties.

In collaboration with *Cardiff Vocations*, the Holy Hour for Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life will take place on the **first Thursday of the month (this Thursday)**, beginning at 5:00pm.

Let us continue to pray for those men and women discerning God's call for them to the priesthood and religious life. If you are considering a vocation to the Priesthood or Religious Life, I am available to talk.

**The Angelus** - The *Angelus* is a popular prayer which commemorates the mystery of the Incarnation. Traditionally, this is prayed at key moments throughout the day: dawn, midday, and around 6:00pm in the evening. One of the recognizable characteristics is the tolling of the bells in a distinctive pattern.

I have begun to pray this each Saturday morning at 9:00am on Facebook Live, broadcast from the shrine chapel of

Our Lady of Penrhys; a prayerful way to begin the weekend. All parishioners and visitors to the Cathedral are remembered in prayer.
