Instructions for Attending the Celebration of Mass - I would like to extend a personal welcome back to the Cathedral to all those who are attending Mass for the first time. As you can see, things are in no way back to normal, yet. The **stewards** are available at the back of the Cathedral to help and guide you. I am very grateful to the stewards for their dedication and commitment. Without them, the Cathedral could not open. The **Track and Trace** system which is in place is there to safeguard visitors to the Cathedral for the celebration of Mass. The Sacrament of Reconciliation - The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available in **the Mostyn Room** at scheduled times throughout the week. Access into the Mostyn Room is via the courtyard. Times of Confessions this week will be:

Tuesday and Thursday:

from 12:00pm until 12:30pm.

Saturday:

from 11:00am until 12:00pm.

If you would like to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation outside of these times, please phone Clergy House to book an appointment.

Offeren yn Gymraeg – Mass will be celebrated in Welsh via live-streaming only on **Friday, 18th September**, beginning at **6:00pm**. I hope that this can be the beginning of a regular Welsh Mass at the Cathedral. I have been practicing!

Evening Prayer (Vespers) – The Liturgy of the Hours is celebrated at the Cathedral throughout the week. Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction takes place each Sunday, beginning at 4:30pm. With the exception of Thursday, During the week, Evening Prayer will begin at the end of Adoration, beginning at 5:40pm (5:30pm on Thursdays).

The Angelus - The Angelus is prayed each Saturday morning, at 9:00am on Facebook Live, broadcast from the

shrine chapel of Our Lady of Penrhys; a prayerful way to begin the weekend. All parishioners and visitors to the Cathedral are remembered in prayer.
