Coronavirus Advice

In the light of the developing Coronavirus situation, the following advice is given to parishes as an elaboration on that already circulated by the Bishops Conference of England and Wales:

1. The usual handshake at the Sign of Peace should not be given. A bow or cursory nod of the hand will be sufficient during this time.
2. The offering of the Chalice at Holy Communion should be suspended until further notice.
3. The Holy Water stoops should be emptied (as they ought to be in Lent anyway) in order to limit the possibility of cross infection.

Lenten Alms - This year, money raised through the Lenten Alms will be for the homeless, both in the city of Cardiff and around the Archdiocese. The collection box for the Lenten Alms can be found at the front of the Cathedral, in the wall safe near the sacristy door, marked clearly with '*Lenten Almsgiving*'. Thank you for your generosity.

Stations of the Cross - The Stations of the Cross are prayed every Friday during Lent, beginning at 12:00pm, and every Saturday afternoon, beginning at 3:15pm. The Stations of the Cross draws us more deeply into the reality, mystery, and mercy of the cross, so that we might experience the love of God more truly and powerfully.

Leaning on the breast of the Lord - Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues throughout the week, after the 12:45pm Mass, ending at 3:00pm.

Sacrament of Reconciliation - There are several opportunities to experience the loving embrace of Christ in the Sacrament of Reconciliation at the Cathedral during the Lenten season:

Archbishop Peter Smith, RIP

Archbishop Peter Smith, Archbishop-Emeritus of Southwark and former Archbishop of Cardiff, died peacefully at the Royal Marsden Hospital, Chelsea, just before midnight on Friday, 6th March. Archbishop John Wilson, writing to the clergy of Southwark, said: "*Archbishop Peter had received the sacraments and prayers of the Church and was visited in hospital by family and friends. I was able to visit him earlier that evening and he was also visited by Cardinal Vincent Nichols, the Archbishop of Westminster*". May he rest in peace.
