Light Up Our Lady

Last week, the electrical engineers spent the week restoring lights to the shrine chapels of Our Lady of Penrhys, the Sacred Heart, and the Welsh Martyrs. As well as this, they have installed a spotlight on the crucifix above the tabernacle, and have begun essential repairs around the Cathedral. This has been achieved through your generous support. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your ongoing commitment. These works are only the beginning of upgrading the electrics at the Cathedral. As the estimate for the upgrading of the electrics is so high, this will need to be done in phases. We have asked for a quotation to upgrade the orange florescent lighting in the main body of the Cathedral to something more suitable. I am waiting for this quotation to come through. These works are absolutely essential in making the Cathedral a safe space of encountering the Lord. The 'Light up Our Lady' Fund will remain open if you would like to contribute. There is also a dedicated wall safe at the front of the Cathedral, near the door to the sacristy.

This weekend is my last weekend here at the Cathedral before I begin my appointment as Parish Priest of Our Lady of the Angels and St. David in Cwmbran. In the 95 weeks I have been here as Priest-in-Charge, almost 66 of those weeks have been affected by COVID-19. Indeed, a former lecturer of mine from seminary mentioned to me recently that this pandemic will shape priestly ministry and pastoral care for the rest of our lives. I never thought that such a privileged appointment as this would be framed in such a way. The Cathedral continues to be the centre and beating heart of our diocese; and the fact that we are able to welcome so many people into the Cathedral, whether physically, or virtually, demonstrates this.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the clergy who have supported the ministry of the Cathedral in the last year and a half: to Archbishop George, for his care and continued guidance and support, to Canon Mike Evans, for taking me under his wing, and keeping me out of mischief(!), Fr. Paul, for his assistance at the Cathedral, and the Fathers and Brothers of the Cardiff Oratory-In-Formation for the fraternity.

Our Cathedral stewards, although small in number, have enabled the Cathedral to remain open for Masses as well as throughout the week for private prayer. Barry, in particular, has offered me a support which far exceeds merely the practical support, and for this I am eternally grateful. Thank you!

Please be assured of my continued prayers, and I would ask that you continue to pray for both myself and Fr. Robert as we prepare to take up our appointments.
